SUBJECT: Reprimand.

TO : Captain Felson, Company Commander, Company C, 10th Medical Battalion.

1. An enlisted man of your command was stopped when found driving a vehicle containing a mahogany table. When apprehended he professed ignorance of any wrong doing and said that a *Lt. Col.* Captain under your command had directed him to a building in *the* *for the purpose of removing said table and appropriating it for company use.*

2. This is a direct violation of NATOUSA, Fifth Army and 10th Division directives and standing orders.

3. Failure to comply with the orders was not the fault of the Officer or Enlisted Man concerned but can be traced directly to the Company Commander for failure to acquaint all the personnel under his command with the provisions of these orders.
